

Home Safety Checklist: Fall Prevention Room by Room

General Home Safety	
 □ Adequate lighting in all rooms and hallways □ Light switches easily accessible at room entrances □ Night lights in hallways and bathrooms □ All electrical and phone cords secured away from walking paths □ Handrails on both sides of all staircases □ Non-slip strips on all steps □ Remove or secure loose rugs with double-sided tape □ Clear pathways between rooms □ Emergency numbers posted by all phones 	
Kitchen	
 □ Frequently used items stored at waist height □ Step stool is sturdy with handrail (no chairs for reaching) □ Non-slip mat in front of sink □ Good lighting over cooking and prep areas □ Spills cleaned immediately □ Frequently used heavy items stored where easy to reach 	. <u></u> - = ÷
Bathroom	
 □ Non-slip mats inside and outside shower/tub □ Grab bars properly installed by toilet and in shower □ Shower chair or bench if needed □ Hand-held shower head for seated bathing option □ Toilet at appropriate height (raised seat if needed) □ Door locks that can be opened from outside in emergency

Bedroom	
 □ Clear path from bed to bathroom □ Light/lamp within easy reach of bed □ Phone within reach of bed □ Firm mattress at appropriate height □ Night light or motion sensor light □ Walking aids (if used) within easy reach of bed 	
Living Room	
 ☐ Furniture arranged to create clear walking paths ☐ Chairs and sofas at good height for sitting/standing ☐ Firm cushions that don't sink too deeply ☐ Remote controls easy to locate and reach ☐ No trailing wires or cords ☐ Adequate lighting for reading 	
Outside Areas	0
 ☐ Steps and walkways in good repair ☐ Handrails on all outdoor steps ☐ Good lighting at entrances ☐ Clear, even paths to mailbox and garbage area ☐ Snow/ice removal plan in place ☐ Outdoor furniture stable and well-maintained
